With a simple pattern for the shape of the fish body, and one to two fabrics to create your design, students will experience this technique as a creative "breakthrough" for those who have primarily been traditional quilters.

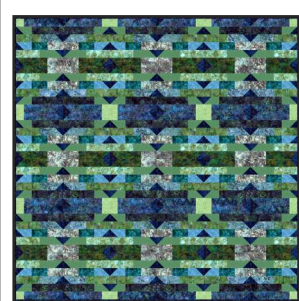

"BLOC Club" – Baltimore Ladies of Orange County QF146



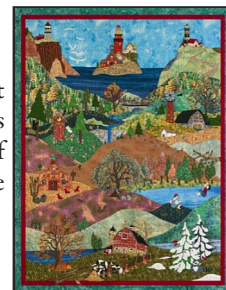
