

To Those Who Have Ears

He that hath an ear, let him heareth what the Spirit saith unto the churches. (Revelation 2 & 3)

In the book of Revelation — which, by the way, is the unveiling of the Christ within us — John doing his best to describe the new creation and how it is birthed and formed and the ultimate beauty of it after its birth. That is not my topic for today. Today I would like to elaborate on the above scripture. You will notice that in chapter two and three John is addressing the seven churches, or the seven sources from which the new creation gets its new supply of life or energy. So if you have ears to hear you will understand all the articles on our internet. Recently I read an article by, I believe, a Dave Garner, and he quoted some of what appeared to be Watchman Nee's teachings. The quote

stated that the speaking in tongues and the gifts of the Spirit were for the babes in the Lord. Because Dave had not gone on beyond the gifts of the Spirit, he asked his readers if they perceived the error in Nee's writing.

What is the Spirit saying to the present day church?? Certainly it is not "get baptized in the spirit and speak in tongues". He is saying admonish one another daily while it is yet called today. He is saying "they will listen and say amen as long as you give them a gospel that tickles their ears." If you give them truth that goes beyond which they care to walk in they will call it error. If you have only gone as far in your walk with God as being baptized in the Spirit you are a most to be pitied "Christian".

Anyone coming to God today will immediately be under the judgment of God for that is what the Spirit is saying to the church today. The temple of the old age is about to be destroyed. Will you be part of the new age being born or will you stay in the cast off old age called the Christian age speaking in tongues and doing all the things the babes did in the sixties and seventies? My friend, truth has marched on. The cross is real, God, the Father is real, the new age called the kingdom of God is real, the resurrection is real and lo and behold, Jesus Christ is Lord of all who have come into the new age.



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
