That change from a child of the night to a child of the day is tremendous. That change means pain, tribulation, rejection, separation from loved ones, and suffering. Our options are not many, and they aren’t pleasant. **“If we lose our life, we gain it or if we save our life we lose it” (Matthew 10:39).** **In both instances life as we know it is history!**

I was writing personal letters to some of the stars (teachers) that showed us the way in the night season and God said, **“Don’t write anymore. It’s too late and they won’t hear anyway.”** They will all meet their master and then each will have to decide. Will he or she be willing to leave his ministry, his hope, his family, or will he perish with the world?
