“And fear came upon every soul; and many wonders and signs were done through the apostles. And all who believed had all things in common. And they sold their possessions and goods and distributed them to all as they had need.” Acts 2:43–45

“Now the company of those who believed were of one heart and soul and no one said that any of the things they possessed was his own but they had everything in common. There was not a needy person among them, for as many as were possessors of lands or houses sold them and brought the proceeds of what they sold and laid them down at the feet of the apostles.” Acts 4:32, 34–35

“But he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved.” (Matthew 24:13)
