Abuse of Power?

Our Senators and Congressmen don't pay into Social Security, and of course, they don't collect from it.

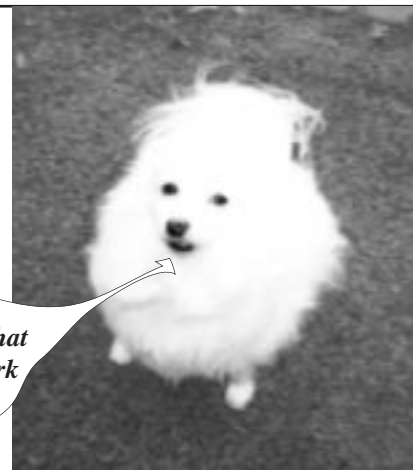


Freckles Says

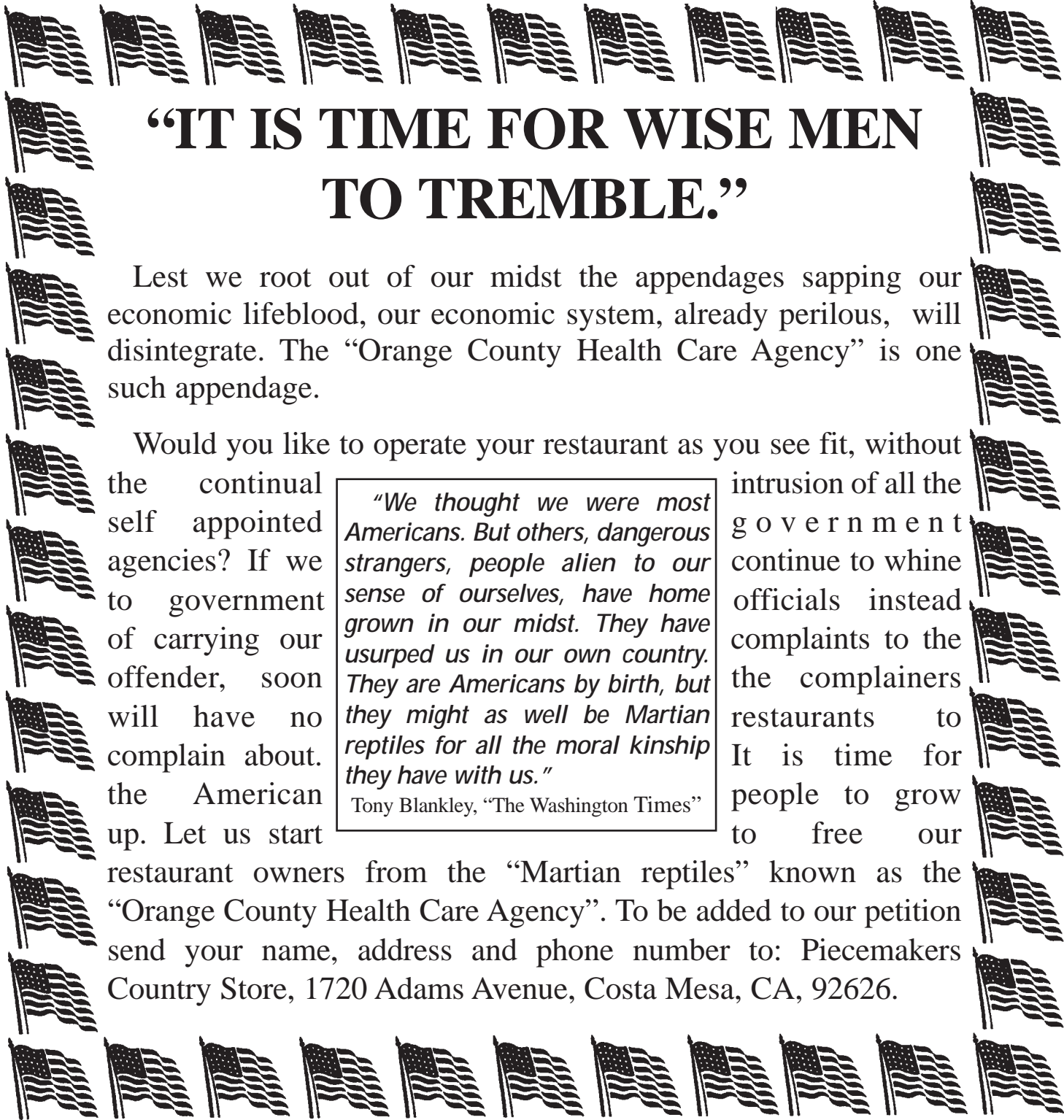

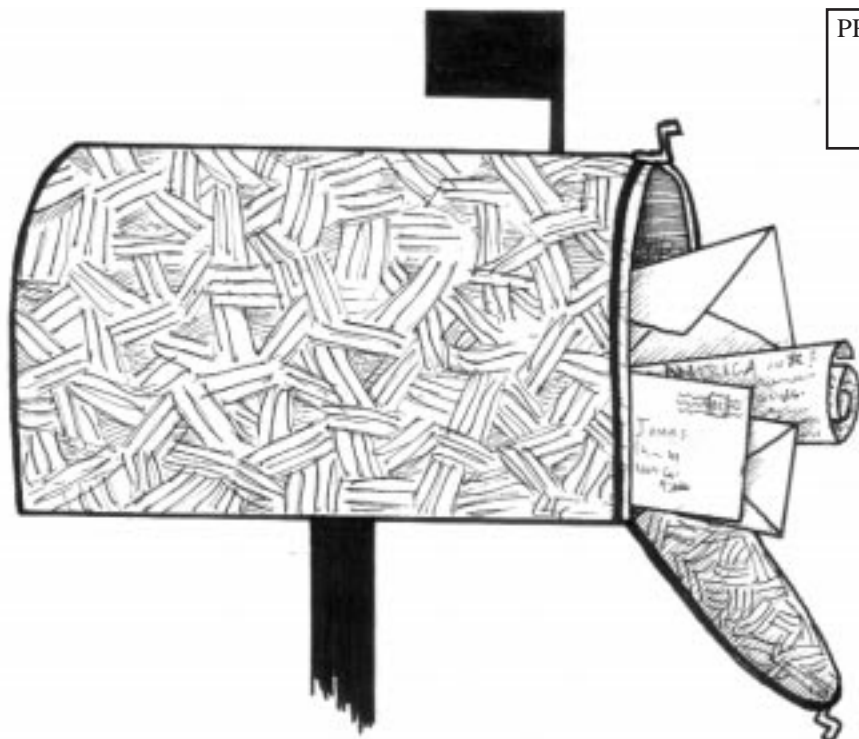
