



The Lighter Side



Below is the letter written by Mr. Watson to Don Lamm, the Deputy City Manager of Costa Mesa.

It's hard to believe that the denial of civil rights and personal freedom engendered in the new Costa Mesa Code Enforcement Program could not be foreseen by its originators.

Regrettably, most of the people living in Costa Mesa have no concept of what freedom is all about, so it is painfully easy to take it away from them. Yet people of good faith in responsible positions, especially city government, have a moral and ethical responsibility to make sure their rights and freedom are preserved.

Those who praise this new program haven't the slightest idea of the dear freedom foolishly being traded away as they gullibly celebrate the pittance of a few property improvements.

I'm no legal mind, but the only way many of those new listed codes can be validly enforced is if, in fact, the U.S. Constitution with its Bill of Rights is invalid.

Might I suggest that the Planning Commission and the City Council fall back on the earlier plan that served us well enough for the 33 years I have lived here and abandon this heavy-handed new program that could place the city in jeopardy of a class action lawsuit



✓ OSHA's latest attempt to protect American workers by bureaucratic fiat may cost businesses and consumers billions of dollars.

Harold J. Bursztajn, a professor in psychiatry at Harvard University says, "You have situations where people feel more comfortable expressing feelings of job dissatisfaction via complaints about workplace health and safety...Rather than have broad rules that attempt to cover all situations, you need to examine the person who is making the claim." [Wonder how the health of the complainer will be when his job is no more.]

Junfortunately, such advanced medical thinking may take years to penetrate the bureaucracy, particularly when it threatens OSHA's current grip on the necks of the nation's employers. "David and Goliath" Update

Update on our "David and Goliath" court battle —
